



#### FROM THE PASTOR

The Heidelberg Catechism says that belief in the providence of God makes it possible for us to be "thankful when things go well" and "patient when things go against us" (Q&A 28). So sometimes we are thankful, and sometimes we are patient. Paul says that it is God's will for us to be thankful "no matter what happens" (I Thess. 5:18).

That might not seem very realistic, but may it help to note that Paul did not say we should be thankful FOR all circumstances, but instead be thankful IN all circumstances. Things might get difficult for us at times. There are days and seasons that are filled with joy and ease, and times where we are overwhelmed by troubles and hopelessness. No matter what happens, God is there walking with us.

How can we remember to be thankful when things are great, and find reasons to say "thank you" when things are difficult?

Perhaps a spiritual discipline called "The gift of noticing" can help. Sit still. Notice what you have. Notice who is with you. Notice the things that bring you joy or peace or love. Keep noticing when you get up to move. Make an ongoing list of the gifts that God gives. And offer prayers of thanksgiving!




# World Communion Sunday

# **BACKPACK PROGRAM**

We are grateful for the leadership of Dave Foster and Janice Johnson who organize our weekly food program with children at Roosevelt Elementary School. We are currently serving 51 students by providing weekend "backpacks" of simple, nutritious food.



We would like to thank all the volunteers for their hard work and dedication. From helping pack the backpacks, to their generous donations. With out you, we couldn't make this ministry what it is today. We have given **1054 backpacks** since the beginning of January through the September.

#### MISSION COMMITTEE

The Mission Committee met on October 1st and decided to make a Global Mission donation of \$1,000. to Presbyterian Disaster Assistance. Their Local Mission Giving for October was to the Miami Public Library (Excel Program) \$1,100.




The Mission program is sustained in part by gifts from the Myers Sisters bequest and gifts from you. You can designate gifts to "Local Mission" or "Global Mission". The Deacons Shoe ministry has delivered **24** pairs of shoes in the year 2024.

The Food Pantry distribution average for last year (2023) was 54 bags/month. So far, in 2024, we have given out **598** bags of food, as of **October 24, 2024**. **67** Bags just in **October as of the 24th of the month.** Your contributions of food and dollars makes a difference in many lives.

The feeding programs at First Presbyterian Church have been welcomed as a partner agency of the Community Food Bank of Northeast Oklahoma. This means that we will have access to better quality food at lower prices for our Food Panty and our Backpack program. In addition to bulk food available at a flat rate (currently 16 cents per pound), we will have access to other discounted foods and will hopefully be able to expand to fresh produce and frozen meats.


