
They also brought in a second box with numerous canned goods in it a week later.



Food Pantry & Deacon Donation


We here at FPC Miami were blessed by receiving a generous offering from a church member of \$1500 for the Food Pantry and \$1500 for the Deacon's Fund.

We are grateful for the leadership of Dave Foster and Janice Johnson who organize our weekly food program with children at Roosevelt Elementary School. We are currently serving 51 students by providing weekend "backpacks" of simple, nutritious food.



We would like to thank all the volunteers for their hard work and dedication. From helping pack the backpacks, to their generous donations. With out you, we couldn't make this ministry what it is today. We have given **954 backpacks** since the beginning of January through the September.

4th Annual NEOK/Miami Pridefest Sept. 21, 2024














We even had one person from the event show up the next day at Sunday Service.


What a humbling and honoring experience it is to spread God's love to those who thought they were not worthy or accepted by God. Only God knows how many seeds were planted in people's lives this day.
